Minimum College Entrance Requirements for the state of Washington

English 4.0 credits-3 credits of literature and composition (College prep. or AP preferred); check specific colleges regarding debate and other English electives
Social Science 3.0 credits - History or other social sciences
Math (plus senior year) 3.0 credits - Algebra, Geometry, and Algebra II; senior year math-based course (can be CTE course) or algebra-based science is sufficient (completing Pre-Calculus or higher prior to your senior year can exempt you from the senior year requirement)
Science (at least 2.0 lab) 3.0 credits-At least one of must be in an Algebra-based science course as determined by the school district. One credit must be in: Biology, Chemistry, or Physics. Western Washington University specifies that one credit must be an algebra-based chemistry or physics course.
Arts 1.0 credit-1 credit of fine, visual, or performing arts—or 1 additional credit in CADR subject areas
World Languages 2.0 credits-2 credits of the same world language, Native American Language, or American Sign Language
