



Groundbreaking Announcement New Stanwood High School



Stanwood-Camano School District will be holding a groundbreaking ceremony at 7400 – 272nd St NW, Stanwood, WA 98292 on **Wednesday, May 23, 2018 at 4:00pm**. This event is open to the community and will be at the top of the hillside, north of the ball fields.

The new Stanwood High School is part of the \$147.5 million bond package that community voters approved in February 2017. The estimated construction cost of the new Stanwood High School is \$76 million.

The groundbreaking will feature brief remarks from School Board President – Julie Dean, Superintendent – Jean Shumate, Stanwood High School Principal – Christine Del Pozo, and others.

Stanwood High School opened in 1971, replacing the older Twin City High School, and was originally built with a “California-style” campus, which provides multiple points of access to clusters of buildings. Renovations to the existing buildings were done in 1980 and 1993. In 2001, the high school was expanded and improvements were made, but overcrowding forced the use of portable classrooms in recent years. The new building will be ready for students in September of 2020.
