



Stanwood-Camano School District Poster Contest

The Stanwood-Camano School District is holding an anti-bullying poster contest to bring awareness to how hurtful bullying is and how important respecting other people and treating them the way you would want to be treated is.

Here are some important pieces of information related to the contest:

- Each school in the district will be able to submit the following number of posters:
 - K-2 (2) per school
 - 3-5 (2) per school
 - 6-8 (3) per school
 - 9-12 (6) Stanwood High School and (4) for Lincoln hill

- **Criterion for the posters follows:**
 - Size must be 11x17 or 8 ½ x 11 (please do not write words close to the edge of the poster)
 - There must be an appropriate message or slogan and a drawing or symbol. Example follow of slogans follow:
 - “Be Nice”
 - “Bullying Hurts”
 - “Be Caring”
 - The material or medium used should be as follows:
 - 2 Dimensional
 - Colored ink or black ink
 - Crayon
 - Something that could be re-created/copied
 - Due Dates:
 - To your school- **Friday, October 4th, 2019**
 - Schools turn into the District Office by **Monday, October 7th, 2019**

- **Judging and Prizes:**
 - Each poster can only be submitted by one student
 - Each student who is selected at his/her school will receive a certificate of award
 - Gift cards will be awarded to the following the 1st, 2nd and 3rd places for each grade band at the District Level: 3-5, 6-8 and 9-12
 - Judging will be conducted by the District Key Communicator Volunteers
 - Winners will be selected by **October 9th** and notified at the **October 15th Board Meeting**
 - By submitting a poster, you are giving permission for the poster to be copied and displayed
