FAQ for school closure
March 11th - April 24th, 2020 – updated March 25th

Advanced Placement (AP) testing: We have been in contact with College Board about the AP tests. College Board will offer AP tests online. Testing dates will be released to you by April 3rd. A letter was sent home with all the updated information.

Advisory lessons and Xello: Stay tuned for more information on finishing up your advisory Xello lessons.

Activities and Athletics: There will not be any practices or competitions from March 11th through April 25th, 2020.

Attendance Meetings: After school attendance meetings have been cancelled for the duration of the school closure.

College in the High School: We have been in contact with the College in the High School representative from Everett Community College regarding our college credit classes. The teachers will start these courses again on Monday, March 30th. Students should check their school email for information from the teachers as to what they need to do.

Fees/Fines: The high school office is not open right now. Please send any fees/fine money to either the high school or district office by mail.

Fire Service: This program is following the same protocol as the rest of the school in regards to coursework. We will contact cadets as more information is available.

Food Bank: The Food Bank, located at 27030 102nd Ave. NW, Stanwood, is open now for all families for food distribution Wednesday & Friday, 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM, and Saturday 10:00 AM to Noon. Families will check in outside with a staff member and then go back to their car to wait. The Food Bank will add fresh ingredients to their pre-packed boxes of food and deliver it outside. Families will get a call or text to pull up in the 'pick up' lane to get

Graduation ceremony and other Senior Class of 2020 events: We will be sharing information with seniors and their families in the next few weeks regarding graduation and other senior events.

Graduation Verification: To verify that a previous student has graduated, please fax an Education Verification form to (360) 629-1331. Please provide the following information for the student: Full legal name while attending SHS, birth date, grad year, signed release (may be electronic).

High School and Beyond Plan: Seniors will still need to complete the high school and beyond plan to satisfy their state graduation requirement. We will send information to seniors in the next few weeks.

How will we make up the school closure days: The Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction has confirmed that the last day of school can not be extended past June 19, 2020 for any districts in Washington State.

Library textbooks and other books: Please hold on to any library books you have checked out. We will have you return those items when we reopen.

Nutrition information: The district is offering a food program at Twin City Elementary (26211 72nd Ave. NW), Stanwood Middle School (9405 271st St. NW), Elger Bay Elementary (1810 Elger Bay Road, Camano Island), and Cedarhome Elementary (27911 68th Ave NW Stanwood). Free grab-n-go breakfast and lunch will be provided from 10:00AM-1:00PM, Monday through Friday. Meals for children age 0-18 (children must be present) will be delivered to cars (or walkers may pick up a meal at the door). The Stanwood-Camano Foodbank will also be at these schools at this same time to provide boxes of food for families in need. (Boxes will be delivered to cars.)

RAP Center: Students in this program will follow the same protocol as the Marysville School District. We will contact individuals in the program as more information becomes available.

Records request: To request records for a previous student, please fax a records request to (360) 629-1331.

Registration for classes for 2020-2021: Information about registering for classes for the 2020-2021 was mailed home. Students need to complete the registration process by April 6th. Registration information can also be found online at the high school website (click on For Students and then select 2020-21 Registration).

Smarter Balanced Assessments (SBA) and Washington Comprehensive Assessment of Science (WCAS): The state tests for this spring have been cancelled by the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI).

Traffic Safety Education: The current traffic safety session is temporarily suspended until further notice. Parents/guardians and students will be contacted when we are able to resume the session.

Truancy court: All scheduled truancy court cases will be suspended for the duration of the school closure. Truancy cases will remain open and new court dates will be set upon the reopening of school.

Use of facilities during closure: Due to the school district closure, all school buildings and facilities are closed to the public including students. This includes the fields, tennis courts, and gyms.

Workforce development: The program is currently on hold. Students will be notified with changes and more information as it becomes available.
