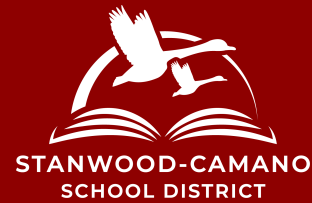

- Sign-out

- Reunification Incident Command Organizational Chart

- Reunification occurs when a school site needs to be evacuated in a crisis.
- Practice of the protocol with staff, students, law enforcement and first responders will occur for the second time later this month.

- Monthly School District Safety Committee
 - Supported by Puget Sound Worker Comp.
 - Representative from each work site
- Monthly Building Safety Meeting
 - Facilitated by building representative and a supervisor

Empowered to Learn!

Student Safety Assessments

- Harassment, Intimidation and Bullying (HIB)
 - 69 reported incidences to date
 - 39 met criteria for HIB
 - Most use online reporting system
- Threat Assessment
 - Level 1 and 2 assessments available in the District
