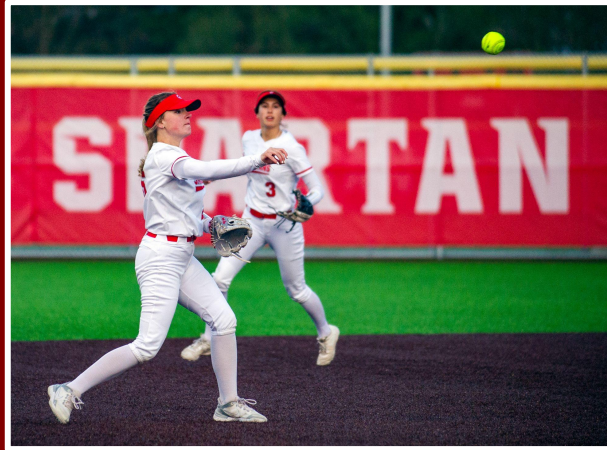

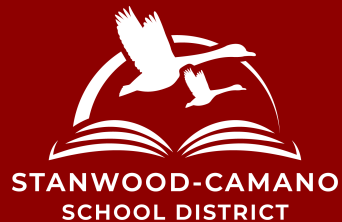

Policy 0100

*Diverse needs among students require equitable, not equal, distribution of resources. Students with a 3.0 grade point average (GPA)

# When will we be doing this?

Fall of 2023

*Data sharing agreement*

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# What happens when a student meets all requirements?

For seniors:

1. Students still apply by filling out the Common App. (colleges are required to collect some additional information, and they want to make sure you are considered for eligible scholarships)
2. Send unofficial transcript to make sure all your high school classes are complete or in-progress
3. Complete the Free Application For Student Aid (FAFSA) or Washington Application For State Financial Aid (WASFA)

*Once the Common App has been completed and unofficial transcripts are sent, qualified students will receive a formal admission packet in the mail.*
