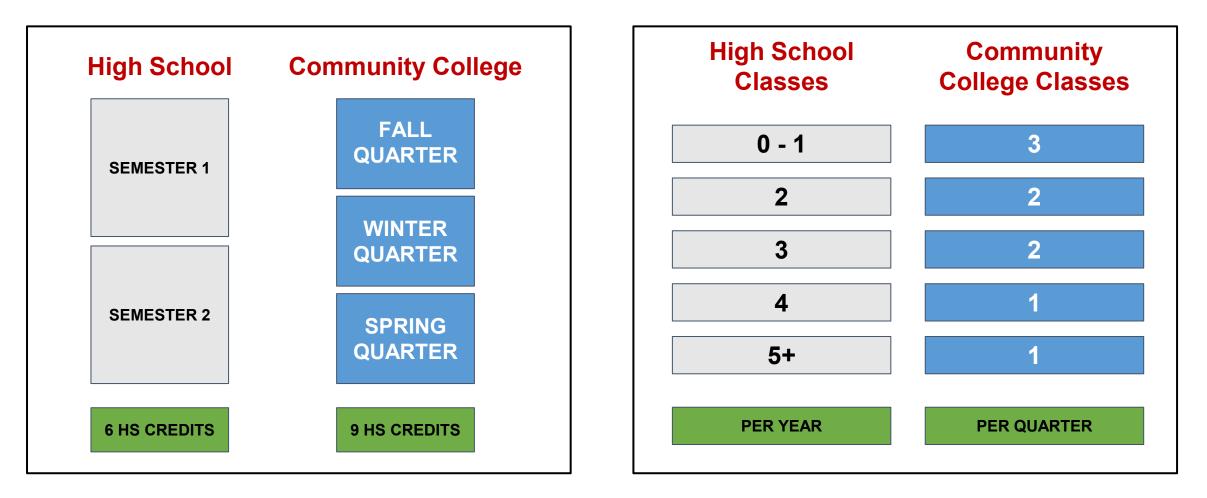

Running Start Credit Eligibility

- Full-Time: 12-18+ college credits
- **Part-Time**: college courses and high school schedule combined

*Students wishing to complete an Associates Degree within two years should complete at least15 college level credits per quarter.

COURSES & CREDITS



1 HS Credit/Class = 5 College Credits (1 College Class)

The left table refers to a credits earned at the community college if a student was a full-time Running Start student.

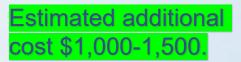
Benefits

- Dual Credit: Transferable college credit

Running Start Application Process

HOW TO APPLY

1. Submit the Running Start application

New EvCC students need to submit the EvCC Running Start online application.

- 2. Submit the EvCC Placement Form Get a copy of your high school transcript and attach it to the EvCC Placement Form for evaluation.
- Complete the enrollment process
 EvCC Online Orientation, Entry Advising, Running Start Enrollment Verification Form
- 4. Register and pay for your fees

*Current EvCC students will submit the <u>EvCC Dual Credit</u> <u>Programs Update Form</u>.



SVC Eligibility & Application Process

- 1. Apply online to SVC as a Running Start Student (USE PERSONAL EMAIL, NOT SCHOOL EMAIL)
- 2. Establish Course Placement (submit HS transcript)
- 3. Meet with your high school counselor to complete the RSEVF (form required for scheduling classes)
- 4. Activate Student ctcLink Account
- 5. Attend a registration event
- 6. Activate SVC email account
- 7. Complete follow up forms
